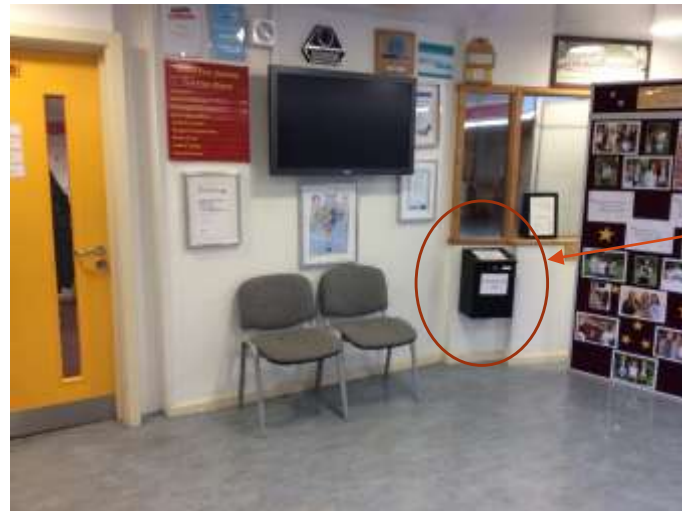
Think - If you were worried about something right now – who would **you** tell?

Confidentiality box

- If you would rather write down what you are worried about, you may write a message and leave it in the confidentiality box.
- Where is the confidentiality box?

It is a metal post box outside the Year Managers' office in the main entrance of school (the one with the mirrored windows).

A Year Manager will read your message and then investigate what you have written.

Child protection is the protection of children from violence, exploitation, abuse and neglect.
