Year 10: Preparing for Next Steps and End of Year 10 Exams

Preparing for Next Steps Workshop

I am delighted to invite you and your child to our Year 10 Preparing for Next Steps workshop, which will take place in school on Wednesday 20 May 2026. Your child is moving into their final year at Cardinal Heenan, a time when they make plans for the next stage of their education and life beyond. This is both an exciting and overwhelming time for both our young people and their families, as the range of post-16 options available to them is vast. It is also a time when the external exams that will determine the pathways that are open to them begin to loom large, as they prepare for and sit their end of year 10 exams.

To help you and your child navigate this time, we have put together an interactive workshop that is designed to help you and your child understand:

- The range of Post-16 Options that are available to them, and begin to consider which will be most appropriate to help them to achieve their goals
- How they can make the most of their final year at Cardinal Henan
- How to prepare for their End of Year 10 exams

The workshop will take place in school on **Wednesday 20 May 2026** in school and last for approximately an hour and a half. There are two available slots: 4pm – 5.30pm and 5.30pm – 7pm. - allow your child and their teacher understand how they are progressing in each subject and identify their next steps
- understand the format of GCSE exams
- learn how to prepare for a exams in a range of different subjects.


Your child will be given their exam timetable at the Preparing for Next Steps workshop, along with guidance on how to revise and how to organize their revision.
