Our 920 students are simply wonderful. We are heavily oversubscribed each year and serve Parishes across Leeds. Our diverse student population is a true reflection of the demographics of Leeds, with 42 different languages spoken, around 20% of our children are classified as pupil premium and around 15% of our children are registered with a SEN status. For the last five years we have been 100% Catholic on intake in Year 7 and this allows us to build an incredible community built around Faith, Hope and Love.

At Cardinal Heenan we believe it is important that our students have a strong grounding in the key subjects that allow them to understand and engage with the world, allowing them to become informed citizens and contribute fully to their community. As such, as students move into Year 9 they will keep a broad core of foundational subjects. To complement this, students study two options subjects, which will allow them to explore new subjects that they have not previously studied and focus further on the subjects that they have found a particular affinity with.

Our School Context

The ethos of our school “to inspire excellence by encouraging every individual to be the person that God calls us to be” celebrates every individual within our school community. We encourage all members of the community - staff and students, to try their best in all situations, celebrating their successes as individuals and collectively through the nurture, care, and guidance we provide for them. By ensuring our focus is on developing every individual our student make exceptional progress in all aspects of their education. Our students’ outcomes year on year exceed the national average in all measures which we are very proud about – consistently amongst the highest-ranking schools in Leeds. However, we also celebrate the individual success that our students have – be that through extra-curricular participation, their contribution to the Catholic Life of the school, their ability to contribute to the school community through countless leadership roles, their participation in a full range of educational trips and visits... the list is endless. Our students leave our school with the qualifications, work ethic and resilience to thrive in Post 16 – the majority of our students progress to Notre Dame Catholic Sixth Form College in Leeds and continue to thrive.



At Cardinal Heenan, a broad and balanced curriculum is an entitlement for all. This is built upon the foundations provided by our rigorous academic core: RE, English, Maths and Science. All students study the full suite of EBacc subjects (Spanish, Geography and History) through to the end of Year 9, and have the chance to explore their interests and talents through the study of creative arts (Drama, Music, Art) and technology (IT and DT). We ensure that our young people understand how to stay healthy and safe, through timetabled PE and PSHCE lessons. We are particularly proud of our bespoke Year 9 curriculum, which allows students to explore their interests in greater depth, understand new subjects available in KS4 and make informed decisions about KS4 pathways. We encourage you to look further at our curriculum models through the information available on the school website.

Safeguarding and promoting the welfare of our students is paramount. Students feel safe and happy at Cardinal Heenan and know that there is always someone who is able to help and support them. We have highly skilled pastoral teams, with a full range of experience, both teaching and non-teaching to provide support and care. We have specialist Child Protection Teams who know our children and families and work tirelessly to remove barriers for our students. We also have very positive relationships with our parents and carers – the primary educators of our children. We always have over 90% attendance at parent consultation evenings and other information evenings, which shows the shared commitment and values that we share across our whole school community.



All staff working within the school recognise how unique our school community is and support me and the wider SLT completely. Staff are keen to contribute, to develop their practice and to go the extra mile - without question. Relationships between the SLT and wider staff body are very positive. We have a very active staff committee who organise socials, support networks etc. and all staff are invited to regular staff forums to share concerns or provide feedback on new initiatives. We do things together for the good of the children in our care.
