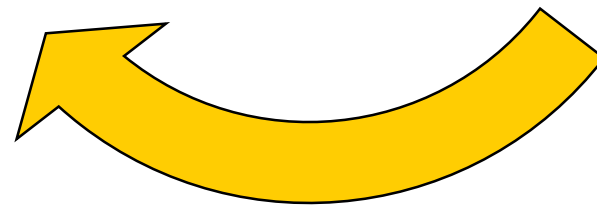
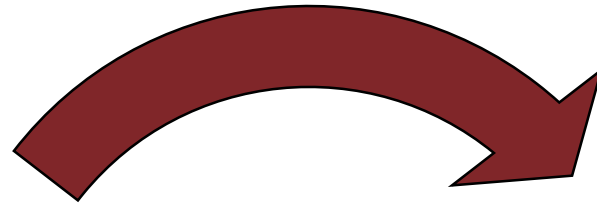

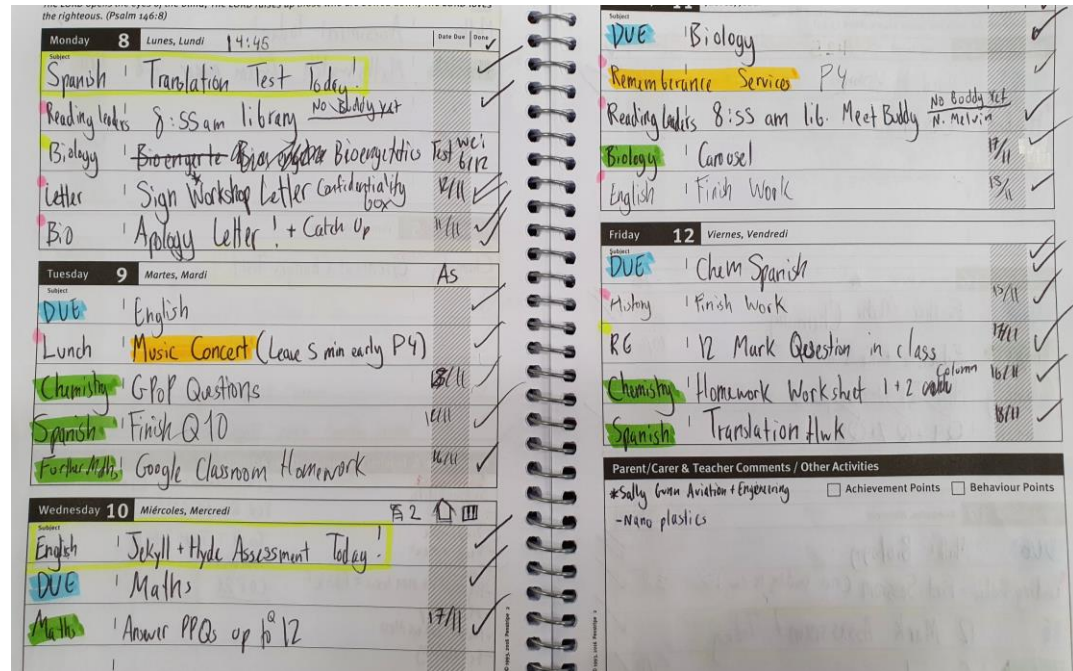

- ✓ Ticks off homework in planner





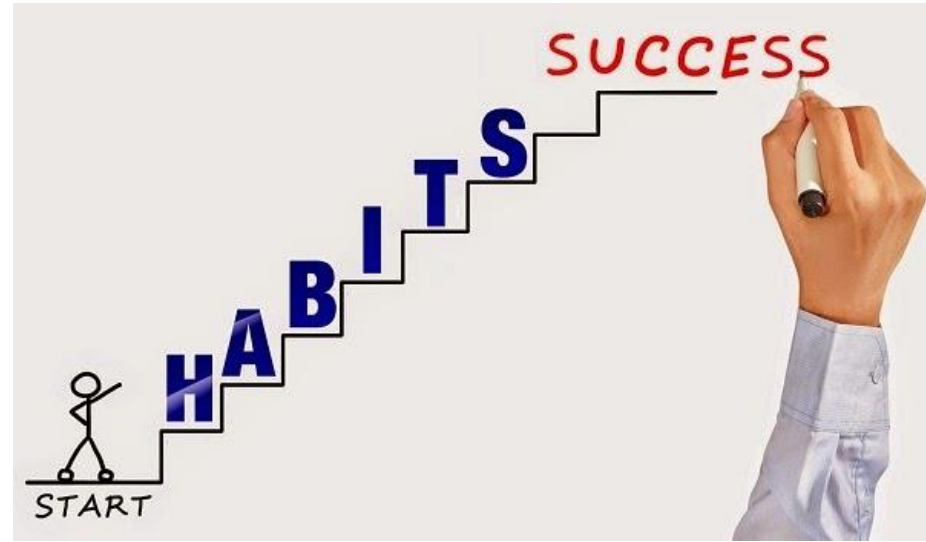
## Student B, Year 7

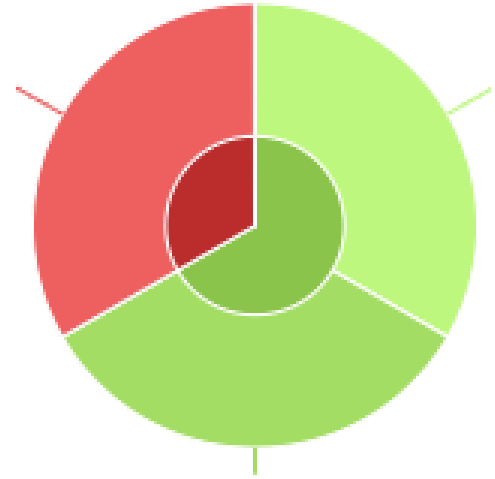
